ALCHOL POLICY

NATIONAL/INTERNATIONAL RIDERS, COACHES, MANAGERS AND OR CHAPERONES

The Pony Club of Australia does not condone the partaking of alcohol by its members and officials at any Pony Club event or by any members and/or officials representing Pony Club in Australia or overseas.

It is therefore the policy of Pony Club Australia that all team members and officials do not partake of alcohol; from the moment they commence representing their state/ country as a team member for a National or International event. This means for National teams from the time they meet at their home airport or if local from the time of arriving at the accommodation and meeting with the rest of the team, until they arrive at their home airport, or if staying on in the state of the event until they leave the event. International riders and chaperones are not to partake in alcohol under any circumstances from the time of meeting together as a team until the team disperses.

TOBACCO POLICY

NATIONAL/INTERNATIONAL RIDERS, COACHES, MANAGERS AND OR CHAPERONES

Pony Club Australia recognises that smoking and passive smoking is hazardous to health accordingly, international riders, coaches, managers and or chaperones are required to comply with the following Pony Club Australia (PCA) Smoking Policy when representing Pony Club Australia in Australia or overseas:

All riders, coaches, managers and or chaperones are to refrain from smoking from the time they commence representing Pony Club Australia as a team at their home airport or if the event is within Australia, from the time of arriving at the accommodation and meeting with the rest of the team, until they return to their home airport, or if the event is in Australia, until they leave the event.
